On behalf of the Productivity and Economic Security theme of the ARC/NHMRC Research Network in Ageing Well, I would like to invite you to apply for funding for a Network supported **workshop** or a **new collaboration** grant.

The fundamental purpose of these grants is to make it possible for researchers from different disciplines and different locales to meet in order to generate multidisciplinary, ambitious research proposals. We wish to stimulate creative new scholarship on the productivity and economic security implications of an ageing Australia, including an ageing workforce. Hence, topics are expected to come from a multidisciplinary perspective and relate to the Productivity and Economic Security theme.

There are two opportunities for funding. One is the **Workshop Program** (maximum of \$5,000). The other is the **New Collaboration Program** (maximum of \$20,000).
